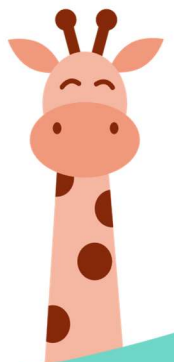
Key roles and responsibilities

- Help prepare babies for the transition into the Toddler Room (24 to 36 months)

Key Requirements:

- Hold a full and relevant early years and childcare qualification at Level 2 or Level 3 (in Childcare, Early Childhood)

- Good knowledge of the EYFS
- Willing to progress in terms of leadership within the company



Key requirements

- Childcare qualification at Level 2 or Level 3 or above (such as Early Years Educator, NVQ Level 3 in CCLD, Level 3 Diploma for the Children & Young People's Workforce), or equivalent qualification.
- Minimum 2 year' experience of working in a nursery/early years setting
- Good knowledge of the EYFS
- Be flexible and patient
- Be able to communicate effectively within a team
- Good level of English (written and verbal)
